

1. SGC will make a DIN application. They have been informed that fees are associated with the process and that the fee is retained regardless of the outcome of the application. They were provide with the TPP website address to access the e-form.
2. A meeting will be scheduled between the two parties to brief and inform the parties and Dr. Bonnie Kaplan of the role of Health Canada in clinical trials (CT). Such meeting will take place in Calgary. Subsequent to the original teleconference Mr. Stephan telephoned back after making contact with Dr. Kaplan. A meeting has been scheduled for the afternoon of May 29th, in Calgary at the Health Canada offices (Harry Hayes Building). Exact time of the meeting will depend on morning flight schedules.
