CALL TO ORDER AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The meeting was called to order by Dr. Ferry Chappell. The minutes were reviewed. Dr. Bickle noted that she has 3 projects active not 4. Also, she stated she was to research the monitoring of sites. A motion was made by Dr. Geurkink-Born and seconded by Dr. Bickle to approve the minutes. The vote was 9-0 in favor.

PROJECTS FOR REVIEW: Preliminary review of Dr. Hauser's project-Investigative Treatment Protocol Employing Intravenous Human Secretin in the Treatment of Autism. Dr. Bickle stated that it would need an IND Questions reviewed were if synthetic secretin has approval for use, if it was to be a multi-center. LIL's need to be checked for bacteria. 2 injections would be used instead of routinely 4 injections, the cost should be stated, more specific numbers should be included in the consent form, more endpoints and requested the protocol that they were using. Ms. Neuzil contacted Dr. Hauser regarding the question. He stated to her that he was aware they would need an IND, LIL is were not used by Hortz the lab he uses, there was no set protocol for the multi-center mentioned in his study, he also stated to her that Great Smokles was not included because he didn't want too many variables.
