Dear Dr. Bajwa:

This letter is official notification that pursuant to Term 2 of a Consent Order entered April 8, 1991, you have been scheduled to meet with an informal conference committee of the Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") on Saturday, October 3, 1992, at 12:30 p.m. at the offices of the Department of Health Professions, 1601 Rolling Hills Drive, Conference Room 1, Richmond, Virginia. The conference will be conducted pursuant to Sections 54.1-2919 and 9-6.14:11 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code").

An informal conference committee ("Committee"), composed of three members of the Board, will review your compliance with the terms and conditions of indefinite probation imposed upon your license to practice medicine in Virginia.

You may be represented by an attorney at the informal conference. The following actions may be taken by this Committee:


1. If a majority of the Committee is of the opinion that a suspension or revocation of your license may be justified, the Committee shall present to the Board in writing its findings, and the Board may proceed with a formal hearing;
2. In the event the Committee finds that you have violated the terms of your indefinite probation, the Committee may reprimand or censure you; or
3. The Committee may continue or modify the terms and conditions of your indefinite probation for such time as it may designate and direct that during such period you furnish the Committee or its chairman, at such intervals as the Committee may direct, evidence that you are not practicing your profession in violation of the provisions of Chapter 29, Title 54.1 of the Code, which governs the practice of medicine and other healing arts in Virginia.

Should you fail to appear at the informal conference, the Board may proceed to a formal administrative hearing in order to impose sanctions. Please inform this office whether you intend to appear at the conference at least ten (10) days prior to the scheduled date above. Also please provide the Board with a telephone number where you may be reached.

Consent Order dated April 8, 1991

ORDER

Pursuant to Sections 9-6.14:11 and 54.1-2919 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code"), informal conferences were held regarding Manjit R. Bajwa, M.D. on October 3, 1992 and February 4, 1993. Members of the Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") serving on the informal conference committee ("Committee") were: Tony C. Butera, D.P.M., Chairman; Walton M. Belle, M.D.; and Karen E. Knapp, M.D. Dr. Bajwa appeared personally before the Committee on October 3, 1992 and was represented by counsel, John D. Grad, Esquire on October 3, 1992 and February 4, 1993. The purpose of the informal conferences was to review Dr. Bajwa's compliance with the terms and conditions of indefinite probation imposed upon her license to practice medicine in Virginia, as set forth in a Consent Order of the Board entered April 8, 1991.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Having considered the evidence presented, the Committee finds that:

1. Dr. Bajwa is in full compliance with the terms and conditions of the Board's April 8, 1991 Consent Order and her practice supervision protocol.
2. Dr. Bajwa is currently engaged in a post-graduate course of study in pain management.
3. By her own testimony, Dr. Bajwa plans to continue to practice in the specialty of acute and chronic pain management. Further, Dr. Bajwa states she never intends to resume the practice of anesthesiology.
4. Since entry of the Board's Order of Summary Suspension dated October 19, 1990, Dr. Bajwa has not taken any additional training in anesthesiology.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Committee concludes that Dr. Bajwa is properly before it, and that this Committee is responsible for approving and reviewing all information relative to Dr. Bajwa's compliance with the terms and conditions of her indefinite probation, and has the discretion to modify or continue the terms of the Board's April 8, 1991 Consent Order.


ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the indefinite probation imposed upon the license of Manjit R. Bajwa, M.D. to practice medicine by Consent Order of the Board entered April 8, 1991 be TERMINATED upon receipt of a notarized letter from Dr. Bajwa's restating her testimony that she never intends to enter into the practice of anesthesiology in the Commonwealth of Virginia or any other jurisdiction.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2919 of the Code, any request for a hearing before the Board must be filed within 30 days of receipt of this Order.

Pursuant to Section 9-6.14:14 of the Code, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
