The Executive Director of the Health Care Assistants Program, on designation by the Secretary of Health, makes the allegations below, which are supported by evidence contained in program case file No. 2000-08-0003HC.

Section 1: ALLEGED FACTS

- 1.1 Paula R. Bickle, Respondent, was issued a certificate to practice as a health care assistant in the State of Washington in September 1998.
- 1.2 In a January 29, 1998, Agreed Order, Respondent agreed to pay a fine in the amount of \$5,000.00 in eight (8) installments of \$625.00.
- 1.3 Respondent has failed to make four payments for the months of March, June, September, and December 1999, and is in noncompliance with the January 29, 1998, Agreed Order.

Section 2: ALLEGED VIOLATIONS

- 2.1 The violations alleged in this section constitute grounds for disciplinary action pursuant to RCW 18.130.180 and the imposition of sanctions under RCW 18.130.160.

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2.2 The facts alleged in paragraphs 1.2 through 1.3 constitute unprofessional conduct in violation of RCW 18.130.180(9), which provides in part:

RCW 18.130.180 Unprofessional conduct. The following conduct, acts, or conditions constitute unprofessional conduct for any license holder or applicant under the jurisdiction of this chapter:

...

(9) Failure to comply with an order issued by the disciplining authority or a stipulation for informal disposition entered into with the disciplining authority.

Section 3: NOTICE TO RESPONDENT



If Respondent fails to defend against these charges, Respondent shall be subject to discipline pursuant to RCW 18.130.180 and the imposition of sanctions under RCW 18.130.160.
