



Whereas on October 9, 1998, the Superior Court of Richmond County, Georgia, pursuant to an order which is attached hereto as Exhibit B, accepted the plea agreement and sentenced Dr. Borison to, among other things, a \$125,000.00 fine and 30 years of imprisonment, with no more than 15 years to be served in confinement and the balance of the sentence to be served on probation, and

Whereas on October 19, 1998, Dr. Borison executed a Voluntary Surrender, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit C, by which he surrendered his license to practice medicine in Georgia, and

Whereas the foregoing conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct, including, but not limited to, the committing of any act contrary to honesty, justice, or good morals, within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6), and grounds exist under that section of the General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit his license to practice medicine and surgery or to deny any application he might make in the future, and

Whereas the foregoing conduct constitutes the violation of a law involving the practice of medicine within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(7), and grounds exist under that section of the General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit his license to practice medicine and surgery or to deny any application he might make in the future, and

Whereas the foregoing conduct constitutes Dr. Borison, by false representations, obtaining or attempting to obtain practice, money or

anything of value within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(8), and grounds exist under that section of the General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit his license to practice medicine and surgery or to deny any application he might make in the future, and

Whereas the surrender of Dr. Borison's license to practice medicine in Georgia constitutes having a license to practice medicine or the authority to practice medicine revoked, suspended, restricted, or acted against within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(13), and grounds exist under that section of the General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit his license to practice medicine and surgery or to deny any application he might make in the future, and

Whereas Dr. Borison would like to resolve this matter without the need for more formal proceedings, and

Whereas after reviewing the records of the Superior Court of Richmond County, Georgia, and the Georgia Board, the Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this case as set forth below;

Now, therefore, with Dr. Borison's consent, it is ORDERED that:

1. Dr. Borison hereby SURRENDERS his license to practice medicine and surgery in North Carolina, effective immediately.

2. Dr. Borison shall return his license and registration certificates to the Board within ten days of the date hereof.

3. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Borison and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.


4. Dr. Borison hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Consent Order be served on him.

5. Upon execution by Dr. Borison and the Board, this Consent Order shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof. Additionally, it will be reported to persons, entities, agencies, and clearinghouses as required by and permitted by law including, but not limited to, the Federation of State Medical Boards, the National Practitioner's Data Bank, and the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank.
